

This will be the **second edition of the festival**, following the first in July 2024.

Les Pyrénées envolées is a **one-day event** organized around a short film festival on the theme of Nature and the Imagination. It will take place in the village of Arnaud-Guilhem, in Haute-Garonne, in the village hall and surrounding areas, in the square and surrounding streets.

This is an artistic event that we are committed to keeping free: admission is free. The day will be structured around three screenings of the selected films: an **international screening**, **a French screening**, **and an Occitanie screening**.

A refreshment bar and food trucks will be available for a meal break between the first two screenings and the evening screening. We plan to have a DJ to provide the musical atmosphere, and an outdoor concert at night to close the event. The festival's theme is a **call for creativity in short films**, on a theme that is part of rural life: the relationship with nature.

Thus, the perspective can be offbeat, poetic, supernatural, experimental, visual, comic... depending on the filmmakers who submit their works. The call for films will be made through digital platforms and local networks (film associations in Occitanie). A jury will select the films in competition and award prizes for the best films.

Call for films:

The idea is to create a call for films through a digital platform such as FilmFest... with no festival registration fees for filmmakers, but with fairly clear specifications.

Specifications:

Dreamlike on the subject of nature, treated in an offbeat way:

For all Without obcenities Without violence Without sexism etc if in a foreign language, need for French subtitles.

Topic ideas:

Regional Occitanie all public French for all audiences International general public

Selection committee and jury:

A jury made up of people from the village and a few professional artists or filmmakers will first select the films eligible to compete.

During the screening evenings, the jury will select the best film in each category.

There may also be a public vote.

Reward: Laurels (from the village!)

The reward will consist of (virtual) laurels sent to the winners.

"It may seem trivial, but receiving an award, even from a small village on the other side of the world or region, when you sent your film from a town in New Zealand or the depths of Aveyron, can boost the film and make you very happy!" (a filmmaker from the region)


